6. Limitation on Liability

4. Participation/Cancellation

More detailed information on cancellation conditions are given respectively in the Event-specific programme and on the website. Cancellations must be made in writing and shall require written confirmation by the Event Organiser to be valid.

8. Copyrights

The Event-related lectures and documents are protected by copyright and may not be reproduced, disseminated or commercially exploited in whole or in part without the consent of the Event Organiser and the respective speaker. The prior consent of the Event Organiser shall be required on all film and sound recordings intended during the course of the Event. Photographs for private purposes and in appropriate amounts are permitted under consideration of third-party rights. The Event Organiser assumes no responsibility or liability for possible incorrectness of the lectures and documentation.

The Event Organizer reserves the right to change, postpone, relocate or cancel at short notice the entire Event or parts thereof. In the case of complete cancellation of the Event (excepting in cases of Acts of God), paid participation fees shall be refunded or alternatively a free admission pass (credit note) shall be issued.
